#### **Gail Adams School of Art**

Gail Adams School of Art has been offering the highest quality of professional art instruction to children and adults since 1980. The studio was established by Gail Adams and is owned by her long-time student and business partner, Carey-Lynn Link. We have professional artists teaching our classes: Eva Peters-Kooy, Kassandra Rea-Cram, Nathen Wahl & August Zamolsky. The art school offers a variety of programming for artists of all ages and ability levels from Preschool to adults. Weekly classes are offered in two semesters, generally beginning in September & February. These include both General Art classes & a wide variety of Specialized art classes for all ages. General Art classes are also available in Warman & Martensville. We also offer a variety of day camps for children during Easter & Summer break.

## Weekly Classes

#### **General Art Classes:**

Each student works from a reference picture of their choice, either from the wide selection available at the studio or from their own collection. Each new student is given an introductory lesson explaining how to get started on their piece and some of the techniques that will be used. The students then work on their own pieces independently. During the class, the instructor will work with each student individually, going over their piece with them on a one-on-one basis, giving them suggestions, answering questions, and showing techniques appropriate to their piece. The General Art Classes offer instruction in a variety of mediums including pencil, pastel, pencil crayon, acrylic, watercolor and scratchboard.

- Appropriate for ages 6 to adult.
- We may take registration throughout the semester based on class availability for General classes only. The cost would be pro-rated based on the number of classes remaining in the semester
- "Beginner art supplies" are required for all students. Supplies are available at Art Placement in Saskatoon. They will give our students a discount.
- Other optional art supplies can be purchased as needed. Please check with an instructor before starting a new medium.

## Saskatoon classes:

- Cost:
  - One hour class: \$190.00 + GST = \$199.50: \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$149.50 due on or before the first day of class.
  - Two hour class: \$325.00 + GST = \$341.25: \$95.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$246.25 due on or before the first day of class.
- Any missed classes may be made up at any time during the same semester (please check for class availability). Make-up classes will not be carried over to the next semester.
- Drop-in classes are available for current & previous students of our studio. Drop-in's are available during any General art class times that are not full (this may fluctuate throughout the semester) at a cost of \$15/hr (incl GST). Please contact Carey-Lynn for available class times prior to each drop-in class.

#### Martensville classes:

- Instructor: Eva Peters-Kooy
- 10 one-hour or two-hour classes
- Cost:
  - One hour class: \$127.00 + GST = \$133.35: \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$83.35 due on or before the first day of class.
  - Two hour class: \$217.00 + GST = \$227.85: \$95.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$132.85 due on or before the first day of class.
- Classes are available for children or adults as a one hour or two hour class on Tuesdays 5-6, 6:00-7:00 or Tuesday 7:00:-8:00 (ages 14-adult only) beginning Sept. 12, 2017.

#### Warman classes:

- 10 one-hour or two-hour classes
- Cost:
  - One hour class: \$127.00 + GST = \$133.35: \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$83.35 due on or before the first day of class.
  - Two hour class: \$217.00 + GST = \$227.85: \$95.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$132.85 due on or before the first day of class.
- Classes are available for children or adults as a one hour or two hour class on Wednesdays 5:00-6:00, 6:00-7:00, 7:00-9:00 (ages 14-adult only) beginning Sept. 13, 2017.

## **Intro to Cartooning for Children:**

Students will learn to develop their own cartoon characters. Weekly lessons will help students learn how to apply expressions, proportions, and elements of design, to their characters. Teaching methods will include demonstrations, examples, and specific exercises. Students will be introduced to the basics of drawing, and will work from reference images as well as from their own imaginations. They will learn how to construct cartoons and approach an illustration in 3 steps: thumbnail sketches, rough sketches and a finished pencilled illustration. This class is for anyone interested in learning how to draw cartoons, Manga, or graphic novels.

- 15 one-hour classes.
- Appropriate for ages 10 & up.
- Because of the progression of lessons within the Specialized classes, enrollment may not be accepted after the first day of class and make-up classes will not be possible.
- Cost: \$190.00 + GST = \$199.50 + \*supply cost (approx. \$25): \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$149.50 + supply cost is due on or before the first day of class.
- \*A supply cost will be added to the cost of the class. This will cover the cost of consumable supplies to be used during the class time for student projects.
- Classes are available on Mondays from 6:15-7:15 beginning Sept. 11, 2017.

#### **Advanced Cartooning for Children:**

This course will build on the principles of character construction learned in the Introduction to Cartooning class, and will encourage students to consider the other elements involved in cartoon and comic creation, such as perspective, light and shadow, texture, story-telling, etc. The popular manga drawing style will also be explored. Students will work from references as well as from their imaginations. The Advanced class will learn how to finish an illustration with inking, lettering, and colouring with marker. This course will build on the principles of character construction learned in the Introduction to Cartooning class, and will encourage students to consider the other elements involved in cartoon and comic creation including story-telling, perspective, light and shadow, and texture.

- Instructor: Nathen Wahl
- Must have taken Intro to Cartooning previously.
- 15 one-hour classes
- Appropriate for ages 12 & up.

- Because of the progression of lessons within the Specialized classes, enrollment may not be accepted after the first day of class and make-up classes will not be possible.
- Cost: \$190.00 + GST = \$199.50 + \*supply cost (approx. \$35): \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$149.50 + supply cost is due on or before the first day of class.
- \*A supply cost will be added to the cost of the class. This will cover the cost of consumable supplies to be used during the class time for student projects.
- Classes are available on Mondays from 7:30-8:30 beginning Sept. 11, 2017.

#### **Preschool/Kindergarten Class:**

Students will be introduced to the elements of art: line, shape, value, color and texture, through drawing, painting, collage and other activities. The elements of art are considered the "building blocks" of art. By showing the students how to see and use these elements, children will have a better understanding of how art is created by themselves and others.

- 12 one-hour classes.
- Appropriate for Preschool & Kindergarten aged children.
- Because of the progression of lessons within the Specialized classes, enrollment may not be accepted after the first day of class and make-up classes will not be possible.
- Cost: \$157.00 + GST = \$164.85: \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$114.85 due on or before the first day of class.
- Supplies are included in the cost of the class, however, students are required to bring a small sketchbook (no larger than 9x12) & a paint shirt to each class (please label both).
- Classes are available on Saturdays from 9:00-10:00 beginning Sept. 16, 2017.

#### **Primary Art Class:**

Does your little artist love to experiment with art? Drawing, painting, collage, crafts? Go beyond the school classroom art. Students will learn about famous artists, styles & periods in art history from stories written for young children about the artists. Each child will then create their own masterpiece based on the style of the Masters!

- 12 one-hour classes.
- Appropriate for children in grades 1-3.
- Because of the progression of lessons within the Specialized classes, enrollment may not be accepted after the first day of class and make-up classes will not be possible.
- Cost: \$157.00 + GST = \$164.85: \$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$114.85 due on or before the first day of class.
- Some supplies are included in the cost of the class, however, students are required to bring a small sketchbook (no larger than 9x12) & a paint shirt to each class (please label both).
- Classes are available on Saturdays from 10:15-11:15 beginning Sept. 16, 2017.

#### <u>Figure Drawing:</u>

Class objective is to study the human form, working from reference material we will study basic structure of the head & figure. Applying proportion, color, light, shade & shadow we will quickly capture the gesture of the human body. Exploring the principles of foreshortening & developing a visual memory of the physical form. concluding with a development of figures in a composition; using dry or wet medium.

- 12 two-hour classes.
- Appropriate for older teens & adults.
- Because of the progression of lessons within the Specialized classes, enrollment may not be accepted after the first day of class and make-up classes will not be possible.
- Cost: \$260.00 + GST = \$273.00: \$95.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$178 due on or before the first day of class. Suggested supplies: PAPER: newsprint, bond or drawing pad; MEDIUM: charcoal (pencil or stick), conte crayons, one or two single sticks, (black & sepia), medium hardness
- Classes are available on Saturdays from 1:00-3:00 beginning October 14, 2017.

#### Persective & Rendering:

You will learn basic use of principles of geometry to develop spatial logic & spatial imagery; skills in procedure, technique & understanding the underlying perspective principles. Discover how to apply dramatic 3D to your paintings & drawings. Class will emphasize rendering techniques & appropriate choice of medium to translate your ideas into a visual experience. Media can include color pencil, markers, pastels, acrylic or oils. Emphasis will be placed on rendering natural elements; trees, rocks, plants in an architectural or landscape environment; appealing to painting & illustration.

- Appropriate for older teens & adults.
- Because of the progression of lessons within the Specialized classes, enrollment may not be accepted after the first day of class and make-up classes will not be possible.
- Cost: \$325.00 + GST = \$341.25: \$95.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration, balance of \$246.25 due on or before the first day of class.
- Suggested supplies: PAPER: newsprint, bond or drawing pad; MEDIUM: graphite pencil (soft); color range & other medium to be announced at first meeting
- Classes are available on Thursdays from 6:30-9:00 p.m. beginning October 12, 2017.

## Payment terms

- A non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration for all weekly classes, camps or workshops.
- Deposit can be paid by email money transfer (password "artclass") or by paypal or credit card on the website. The balance + classroom supply costs (if applicable) must be paid on or before the first day of class.
- Class fees, minus the registration deposit, will be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given prior to the first day of class. Non-attendance does not constitute notice of withdrawal.
- Refunds will not be processed once classes have begun.
- Payments are accepted by cash, cheque, Visa or Master Card. Any NSF cheques must be replaced by cash for the cheque amount plus a \$20.00 administration fee.
- Gail Adams School of Art reserves the right to cancel any class in the event of
  insufficient registration. In the event of cancellation, the registration deposit and any
  subsequent payments will be refunded in full.
